How would you describe ADM Automation in a nutshell?

ADM develop and manufacture automated machines and systems used in manufacturing and logistics. Our work is leading edge and very innovative. We created the iCart, an 'intelligent' automated guided vehicle used in in-house logistics applications. This part of our business is growing rapidly creating a demand for high calibre staff at all levels.

What are the benefits to a company like ADM Automation to retaining graduate talent?

We have four principles that guide the way we work. The first is expertise: our business is driven forward by opportunities arising from our expertise in automation and manufacturing. By expanding our expertise we will expand our business. We need people who can rise to this challenge and have the capacity and capability to learn new things and push boundaries further and further. Good graduates are essential to our success.

And what are some of the benefits for graduates of staying in the North East for their careers?

In my view Newcastle is the best city in the UK and Northumberland is the most beautiful county, full of history and wide open spaces. If you're in a good job why would you want to be anywhere else?

What kinds of career paths can graduates follow at ADM Automation?

Our requirements are mainly engineering based. Mechanical, electrical, control and software engineers are the roles we mainly look to fill. We take raw graduates and those with experience. Our preference is to grow our own and over the years we've been successful at that.

Can you tell me a bit about what your job involves?

I did my dissertation at the same time as working here at ADM Automation as a Project Engineer. The topic of my dissertation is internal logistics and that very much relates to my job. I am involved in lots of different areas of work at ADM including estimating costs, working with software and liaising with clients. It's a mix of everything and I've learnt a lot very fast.

What do you enjoy the most about your job?

I enjoy the opportunity to travel – I've only been here a few months and already I've travelled to a number of different workshops and meetings around the UK and I get to talk to clients and work with new people all the time. I enjoy everything to be honest and I am learning every day.

Do you plan to stay in the North East after graduating?

I'm due to finish my studies very soon and I hope to stay on here and continue working at ADM. I've been to
